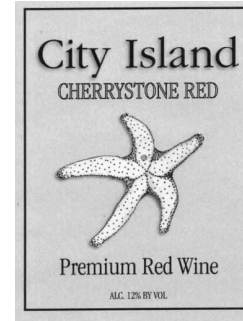

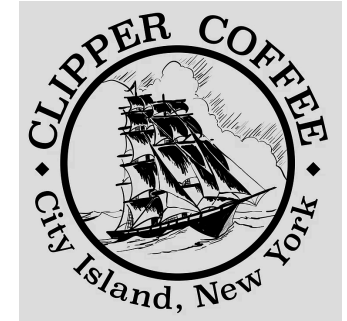

Featured Quiche

- 1 (9 inch) deep-dish pie crust**
- 1 tablespoon olive oil**
- ½ cup sliced onion**
- ½ cup chopped green bell pepper**
- ½ cup mushrooms, sliced**
- ½ cup chopped zucchini**
- 1 large tomato, sliced**
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour**
- 2 teaspoons dried basil**
- 3 large eggs, beaten**
- ½ cup milk**
- ½ teaspoon salt**
- ¼ teaspoon ground black pepper**
- 1 ½ cups shredded Colby-Jack cheese**

Preheat the oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C).

Bake pie crust in preheated oven until firm, about 8 minutes.

Remove crust from the oven and set aside.

Reduce oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).

Heat olive oil in a large skillet over medium heat.

Add onion, bell pepper, mushrooms, and zucchini and cook, stirring, until softened, 5 to 7 minutes.

Remove vegetables from skillet and set aside.

Sprinkle tomato slices with flour and basil; cook in the skillet over medium heat for 1 minute per side.

Set aside.

Whisk eggs, milk, salt, and pepper together in a small bowl.

Spread 1 cup cheese in the bottom of pie crust.

Layer vegetable mixture over the cheese, then top with tomato slices.

Pour egg mixture over top and sprinkle with remaining 1/2 cup cheese.

Bake in the preheated oven until a knife inserted near the center comes out clean, 40 to 45 minutes.
